Also, the system won't allow changing items if the payout is already paid to the provider.

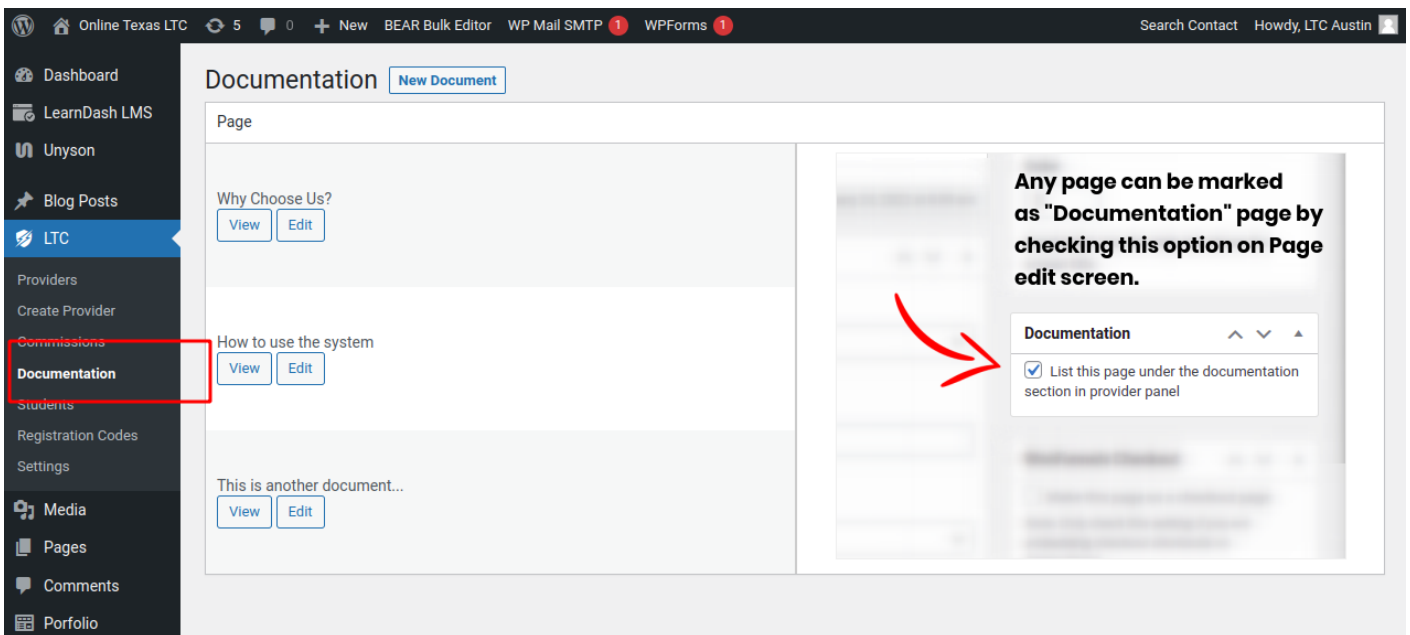
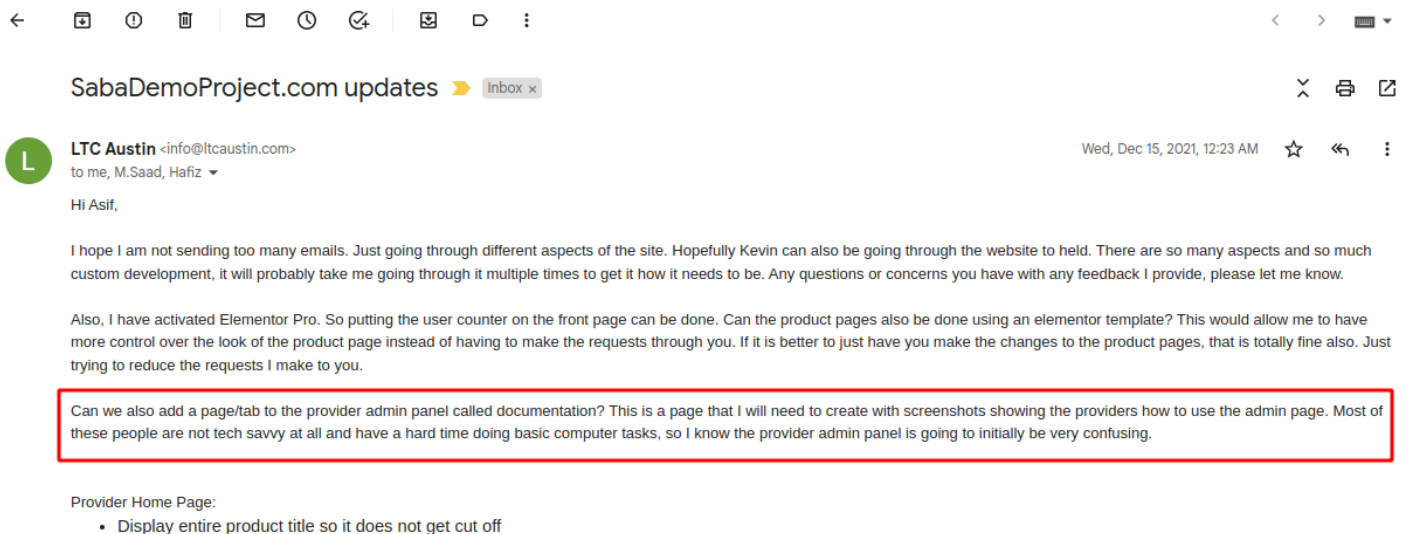
Can we also make it so that if an order is refunded after the commission is already paid out, it will withhold the appropriate amount from the following orders from that provider?

This one had been a tough thing. And took some time to get done as this involved dealing with the money. There could be different scenarios in which ambiguity might be introduced and we needed to make sure things are traceable. We made refund handling possible by creating a **Provider Dues system**. Every time a provider order is refunded, and its payout was already paid to the provider, then this payout amount would be held by the system as the Provider Due. The system would then keep deducting the maximum possible dues from every payout from upcoming orders until the dues are clear. So far we have programmed the refund, dues, and dues deduction logic and gone live. We can later work on the interface and reports, like, Let the provider know by email if they have some dues to pay.

1. How long will the website be up for but we will need to restrict users from logging in and stop new purchases (to prevent any changes to the database)?

> That would be about 7 days minimum. I know it'd be too long, but data is so huge, it takes time processing. If you still think this wouldn't be a feasible option, then we would need to figure out an other strategy and reprogram the migration scripts a bit so this time is as minimum as possible. Please advise.

- 7 days (if not more since you said 7 is the minimum) is definitely too long. It is not just sales that I would be losing, but my 175 providers that sell classes would also be losing sales. As well as angry customers that purchase the class and then they can't even take the class for an entire week. Can the databases that hold order data and student progress just be copied/migrated within a day?

The only solution was a Synchronization system that would pull all the data from the legacy system to the new system. After the complete pull, the system would then keep all of the data in sync as well with the legacy system. The following entities of the legacy system were programmed to be pulled and synced.

1. Providers
2. Providers' Users
3. Students
4. Courses
5. Students' course progress
6. Products
7. Orders
8. Coupon Codes
9. Purchase/Registration Codes
10. DL/ID Informations
11. User Credentials

12. Store Locations (for Prof. Demo. page)

Apart from the sync script, there are several operations that might be needed to be performed after syncing data, so we programmed scripts and interfaces for these actions as well.

1. User roles and capabilities patch ups
2. Activate providers
3. Manually assign wandering products to respective synced providers.
4. Manually assign parent products to imported products (for correct commission calculations as per the new system)
5. Manually assign exported store locations with corresponding Providers in the new system, as well as their opt-in settings.
6. Manually assign redirect URLs so the providers' old store URLs redirect to their new URLs after going live.
7. Setting up the following in LTC Settings.

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LEGACY MODE

Though we've been testing the sync many times, still this would be a good idea, as all other tech giants do, that after going live with the new system, we should allow old users to switch back to the previous version. Just in case of any trouble with the new system. This can be a temporary feature for a month or so. So we can deal with any post-launch issues without compromising on end users' time and money. We can put a BETA badge on the main header of the new site and show a clean notice bar on the my-account page, if the student is an old one, encouraging old users to keep using the new interface while also allowing them to switch back to the old interface. The Old (legacy) interface could be accessed by something like legacy.onlinetexasltc.com.

We'll need to program a little interface script that'll maintain both login sessions at once. So that if a user logs in on the new system, s/he will get a seamless auto login when switching to the previous interface.

This will be only for older users who have already courses in progress at the time of go-live and want to continue on the old interface.

All providers and new students won't be able to switch back to the old interface.

This sounds good. Progress through a class would then also be the same across the new website and the legacy site?
